



The Let's Horse Show Canadian Series is dedicated to promoting and supporting Open Horse Shows across Canada. Our goal is to increase participation while encouraging healthy equine competition rooted in fun, fairness, and family involvement.

Let's Horse Show will track, and tabulate points earned by registered participants throughout the show season and award high-point prizes at year end within designated age groups and divisions.

Membership numbers and accumulated points will be posted monthly on the Let's Horse Show website and Facebook page to ensure transparency and accessibility for all members. Year-End Awards will be presented as follows:

Halter:

- **Youth Year-End Award Champion**
- **Adult Year-End Award Champion**

Yearling Trifecta & Two-Year Old Trifecta: (Paid Into)

- **Halter**
- **Longe Line**
- **In-hand trail**

English Division (Youth/Adult)

Western Division (Youth/Adult)

Walk/Trot Division (Youth/Adult)

Ranch Horse Division: (Youth/Adult)



GENERAL RULES

1. Eligibility:

Year-End Awards are open to all riders and horses competing at participating Open Horse Shows across Canada. A valid Year-End Awards Membership is required to earn points. Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable.

2. Membership:

Membership must be purchased before points count. Points are not retroactive. Memberships are valid from January 1, 2026, to November 1, 2026.

3. Points:

Points are earned only at Open Horse Shows. At breed shows, only All-Breed or Open classes are eligible for points. No futurity classes will be eligible for points at this time.

Ties will be broken by most class wins, then most shows attended. If still tied, awards may be duplicated or decided by committee.

4. Members are responsible for ensuring accurate contact information.



Once you purchase a membership this indicates acceptance of all rules and conditions and that's when tracking of your points will start.

Membership age groups are:

- Youth 17 & Under
- Adult 18 & Over

Membership may create more divisions, but these are the two we'll be starting with.

English & Western Divisions: Youth and Adult

Walk/Trot: Youth and Adult:

- The same rider cannot ride the same horse in walk/trot and loping classes.
- Two riders may not share the same horse unless one rider is walk/trot and one is in the loping classes, OR one rider English and one rider Western.
- A horse/rider combo that competes in a loping class at one show cannot participate in a walk/trot class at any future shows.

Ranch Horse Division: Youth and Adult
